

FAN ENGAGEMENT FORUM | TERMS & CONDITIONS

These **Terms** together with the accompanying **Application Form** set out the **Agreement** between the applicant whose details are shown on the Application Form (the **Member**) and Scottish Rugby Union Limited, trading as Edinburgh Rugby, a company incorporated under the laws of Scotland and registered under number SC132061 whose registered office is at Murrayfield Stadium, Edinburgh, EH12 5PJ (**Edinburgh Rugby**).

The Agreement sets out the expectations for the volunteer Members of the fan engagement forum and Edinburgh Rugby. The agreement is not a contract of employment with Edinburgh Rugby.

The terms of the Agreement are:

1. Duration

Unless terminated earlier in accordance with Clause 5 below, this Agreement shall start on signature of the Application Form by the Member and shall continue until 31 May 2019 (the **Term**).

2. Member's Obligations

2.1 The Member shall:

- 2.1.1. attend all scheduled meetings during the Term;
- 2.1.2. not hold itself out as a representative of Edinburgh Rugby or otherwise associate itself with Edinburgh Rugby except strictly in accordance with and subject to the terms of this Agreement;
- 2.1.3. co-operate with and comply with all reasonable requests of Edinburgh Rugby at all times during the Term and promptly notify Edinburgh Rugby of any factor which could or does impact upon the Member's ability to perform its obligations under this Agreement;
- 2.1.4. not, at any time, whether during or after the Term, disclose to a third party, any confidential information you obtain during the Term which is not available to the public; and
- 2.1.5. not make any statement, orally or in writing, publicly or privately, or act or fail to act in any way which would, or may, in the reasonable opinion of Edinburgh Rugby, be prejudicial to the goodwill and reputation of Edinburgh Rugby or which will or may bring Edinburgh Rugby into disrepute.

3. Termination

3.1. Edinburgh Rugby may terminate this Agreement without liability if:

3.1.1. the Member fails to attend any scheduled meetings during the Term; or

3.1.2 if the Member is in breach of any term of this Agreement.

4. Assignment

The Member shall not assign or attempt to assign in whole or in part the benefit of this agreement without the prior written consent of Edinburgh Rugby.

5. Force Majeure

Neither party shall be in breach of this agreement nor liable for delay in performing, or failure to perform, any of its obligations under this agreement if such delay or failure result from events, circumstances or causes beyond its reasonable control.

6. General

6.1. This Agreement sets out the entire agreement and understanding between the parties and supersedes all previous agreements and arrangements between them with regard to such transactions.

6.2. This Agreement shall be governed by Scottish law and the parties agree to submit to the non-exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of Scotland.
